The Italian Society of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology has just hosted the 48th FEBS Congress ('FEBS 2024'), which attracted more than 2000 participants to Milan for five days of learning, updating, inspiration and networking under the theme 'Mining biochemistry for human health and well-being'.

The congress celebrated the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of FEBS and presented a groundbreaking scientific programme, in fruitful collaboration with the journals of FEBS and representatives of the FEBS Constituent Societies.

Four Nobel Laureates Bruce Beutler, Robert Huber, Venki Ramakrishnan, and John Walker delivered plenary lectures, and more than 2,000 scientists discussed recent milestones in global biochemical research: from the molecular basis of life to infectious, oncological, and degenerative diseases, from new drug design to emerging diseases, from proper nutrition to innovations in biotechnology and biocompatible materials.

The event received extensive <u>media coverage nationwide</u>, with television coverage and more than thirty articles in major newspapers and news sites.

The SIB would like to thank all its members for their invaluable cooperation and widespred participation in the event.
