Call for support for the participation in the FEBS 2024 Congress

The SIB Board of Directors wants to award 100 grants, € 295,00 each, to encourage the participation of SIB young members in the FEBS 2024 Congress “*Mining Biochemistry for human health and well-being*” (29 June - 3 July 2024, Milan, Italy).

Candidates must fulfill the following requirements:

1. be regularly registered to SIB as a Young Member;
2. be under 35 by the call deadline;
3. be the presenting author of a submitted abstract to the Congress.

NB: The SIB financial support cannot be cumulative with the FEBS grant for participation in the meeting. Furthermore, it will be considered penalizing in the evaluation, although not an impediment for application, to have received a similar SIB contribution for participation in previous FEBS Congresses.

Young Members with the above-listed requirements can submit a support request by February 1st 2024 **through the web page** <http://www.sib-biochemistry.it/opportunities/> by filling the application form and uploading the following documents (.pdf files):

1. copy of the abstract submitted to the FEBS 2024 Congress;
2. curriculum vitae including publications list;
3. signed declaration of not having submitted an application for FEBS contribution for participation in the Congress;
4. receipt of payment for the SIB membership fee for the year **2023**.

The financial support will be awarded based on a merit ranking approved by the SIB Board of Directors. It will be transferred upon presentation of the certificate of attendance as a reimbursement of Congress registration fee (€ **295,00**).

Notably, in order to avoid double awards, the SIB financial support will not be awarded to young SIB members that will also be awarded from Young FEBS Forum Committee.

The notification of acceptance will be sent exclusively by email by February 28th **2024**.
